



Gauge Swatch Test

After completing your gauge swatch, go to:

Knit Gauge Swatch

Gauge: 4in x 4in = 20sts x 26 rows

Worked in Stockinette Stitch.

Yarn: Knit Picks Wool of the Andes OR any worsted weight yarn

Needle Size: 7US or 4.5mm

Gauge Pattern

Cast On 32 stitches

Garter Border: Knit all for 4 rows

Row 1: Knit all

Row 2: k4, p to last 4, k4

Repeat rows 1 & 2 until work measures 4 inches.

Garter Border: Knit all for 4 rows

Bind off.



Note: The recommended needle size is just a starting place. If you get 18 or 24 or any other stitch count across 4 inches, you need to use a different needle to get an accurate gauge.

Crochet Gauge Swatch

Gauge: 4in x 4in = 16sts x 10 rows

Worked in Double Crochet.

Yarn: Knit Picks Wool of the Andes OR any worsted weight yarn

Hook Size: H8 US or 5mm

Gauge Pattern

Chain 27 stitches

First row: dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across, turn

Row 1: ch3, dc in next stitch, dc in each st to end, turn

Repeat row 1 until work measures 4 inches.

Bind off.



Note: The recommended hook size is just a starting place. If you get 14 or 18 or any other stitch count across 4 inches, you need to use a different hook to get an accurate gauge.
